- Entries should be published translations of full-length works of imaginative and creative writing of literary merit and general interest, published in the original Arabic after, or during, the year 1967, and first published in English translation in 2013.
- Entries can have been published in English anywhere in the world but must be available for purchase in the United Kingdom via a distributor or online.

- Submissions must be made by the publisher.
